Leicester is home to sporting legends Leicester City Football Club, Leicester Tigers Rugby team, Leicestershire County Cricket Club at the iconic Grace Road, and the acclaimed Leicester Riders Basketball team, meaning there is always something sporty happening in the city



Following their promotion to the WSL, Leicester City Women now play their home games at King Power Stadium and, new for this season, Leicester Tigers have followed the success of the England women's team with the launch of a women's and girls rugby programme in Leicester.

What's more, Leicester's Morningside Arena has also played host to some of the UK's biggest sporting tournaments such as the World Darts Grand Prix, World Snooker Tour and the King Power Quad Nations Wheelchair Rugby Tournament.

New for 2022 is the Hotel Brooklyn, positioned beside the home of the Leicester Tigers. The new hotel will boast 191 stylish bedrooms and offer a window onto both the city of Leicester and the hallowed turf of Welford Road Stadium.

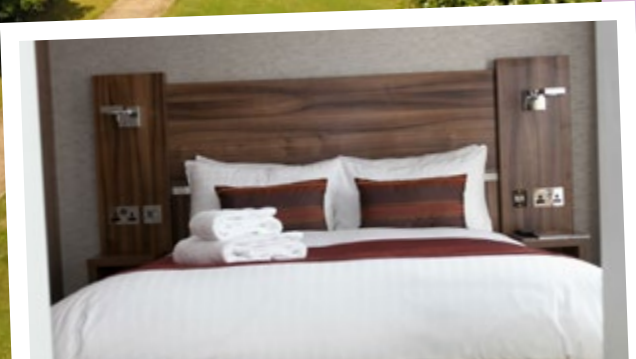


## Make sure you visit

Originally built as a hall of residence for University of Leicester students, this Grade II listed, state of the art hotel and conference facility is packed with quirky design features that reflect its 1960 origins

Its tranquil location amidst four acres of landscaped gardens means its atmosphere is a far cry from that of its student days. A £17 million refurbishment introduced 16 flexible meeting rooms with state-of-the-art audio-visual equipment to sit alongside a range of 123 contemporary and stylish bedrooms, including executive balcony rooms, twins, accessible rooms and suites. All rooms are ensuite and come equipped with high-speed Wi-Fi, LCD TV, tea and coffee making facilities, desk space, high pressured shower and fluffy towels.

College Court's just out of the city centre location in the Clarendon Park area of Leicester means that it's easily accessible from the motorway and guests can enjoy free parking. ## An important part of UK tourism history, the Holiday Inn Leicester marked the centre point of the city's regeneration when it first opened in 1969

Built on land which was originally the Roman and Medieval heart of old Leicester, the area was cleared to make way for the city's modern ring road with the hotel placed upon its very own island. A symbol of progress and change, the hotel was the very first UK Holiday Inn.

Today its location within the Old Town area of Leicester means that it's the perfect base for exploring some of the city's 2000-year-old history, including the **Roman Jewry Wall**, medieval **St Nicholas Church**, **Leicester Castle**, the church of **St Mary De Castro**, **The Guildhall**, **Leicester Cathedral** and resting place of Richard III and accompanying **Visitor Centre**.

The hotel itself offers 194 rooms including Standard, Executive, Accessible Rooms & Family Rooms, including some rooms with two double beds, and, following a refurbishment in 2018, offers visitors an elegant, contemporary and comfortable environment in which to stay. All rooms come with free Wi-Fi, flat screen televisions and a pillow menu to ensure a perfect night's sleep.

The open plan lobby has a Starbucks and an all-day dining menu, and business users are treated to a range of flexible workspaces and meeting areas for up to 300 people. There's also a well-equipped gym, stylish restaurant, and a large bar to enjoy.

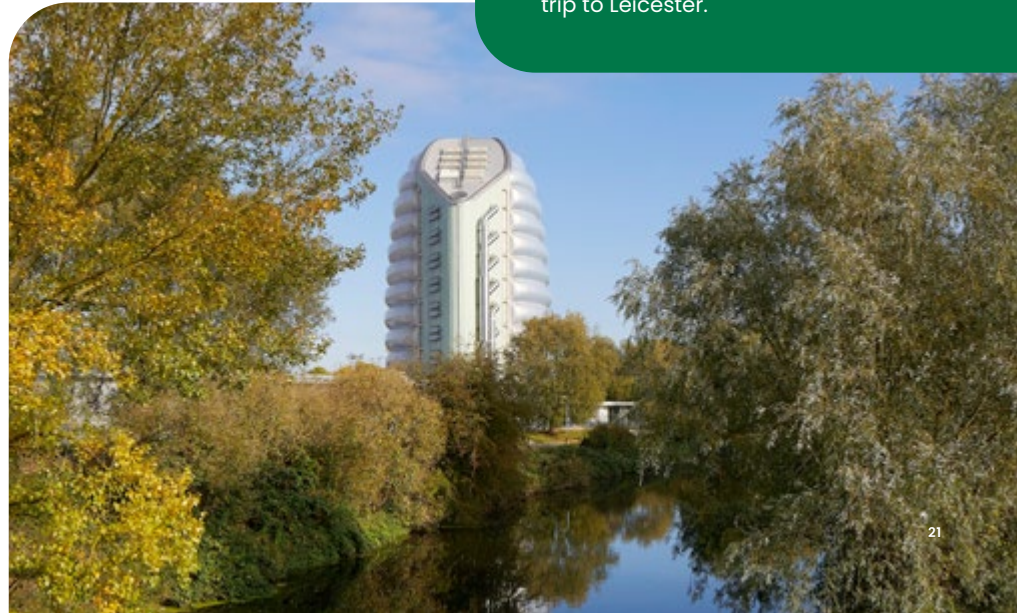

# Discover Leicester's hidden history — right inside your hotel



A treasure trove of Roman and medieval sites, Georgian and Victorian landmarks, Leicester is a haven for history-loving tourists. Book into the right hotel, and you don't even have to leave your room to delve into the city's past

Luxury boutique accommodation **St Martins Lodge**, with its original 18th century townhouse features, overlooks **Cathedral Gardens**. Its surroundings tell the tale of the last Plantagenet King of England both within the **King Richard III Visitor Centre** and the **Cathedral**, where his remains lie.

James Butler's King Richard III statue stands opposite, and another of his works, 'The Leicester Seamstress', represents the city's hosiery industry heritage outside **The City Rooms**. Planned as Leicester's first hotel in 1792 but acting as assembly rooms and

judges' lodgings when the money ran out, it's now an eye-catching events venue and small boutique hotel.

Political icon Winston Churchill visited the **Mercure Leicester The Grand Hotel**, an opulent landmark when it opened in 1898, while Arts & Crafts Movement genius Ernest Gimson's home became **The Belmont**. This elegant townhouse, originally a girls' school, sits on New Walk, a rare preserved Georgian pathway whose statues and museum also offer a potted history of Leicester.



Making history itself in 1971, **The Holiday Inn** was the first of the chain opened in the UK. Close by, discover the **Jewry Wall Museum's** Roman baths and medieval treasures including **The Guildhall** and **The Newarke**, with its links to Richard III and the English Civil War.

Modern hotels also embrace the past. The **Villare Hotel's** rooftop terrace overlooks the medieval High Cross pillar, and **The Gresham** aparthotel resides in the space once occupied by iconic department stores Joseph Johnson's and Fenwick. The **Novotel** serves up history in its **Nine B** restaurant, with interiors inspired by mosaics unearthed where a Roman villa stood, right beneath diners' feet.

Built in 1792 and having undergone a careful restoration, this beautiful Georgian listed building in the centre of Leicester city centre now houses four opulent, boutique style hotel suites, all equipped with king size beds, flat-screen TVs and luxury toiletries in their private bathrooms

This family run hotel's central location means that all of Leicester's local amenities are within walking distance, including shops, bars and restaurants, however its historic Georgian style and age of the building does mean that bedrooms are only accessible by stairs.

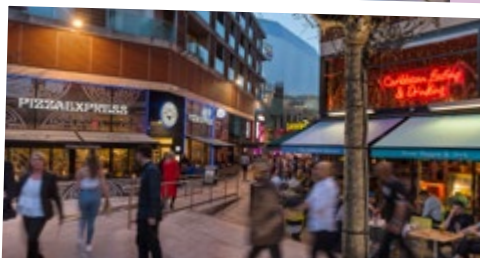

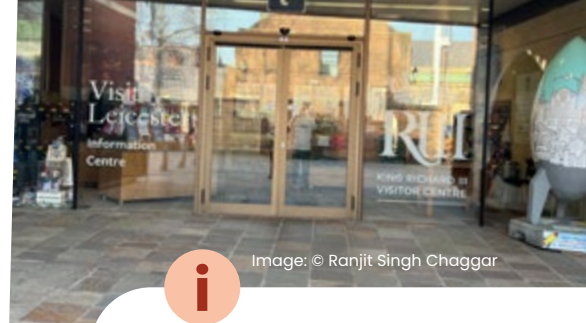
