What is “Always and always facing toward the Light”?

A large-scale 3D projection, live action, theatre and music show that tells the incredible story of Alice Hawkins and the Women’s Suffrage movement in Leicester to celebrate a hundred years of women’s suffrage. With video mapping that brings the Corn Exchange to life.

What are the details?

Location: New Market Square

Date: Sunday 3rd March 2019

Times: There are 3 shows (entry from 20 minutes before performance time)
6:30pm-7:00pm
7:45pm-8:15pm
9:00pm-9:30pm

How do I access New Market Square?

New Market Square is located behind the Corn Exchange and on the night entry to the event will be accessed via Hotel Street down Market Place and Market Place South.

Do I need a ticket?

Admission to each show will be by wristband, which will be available – free of charge – from Visit Leicester Information Centre, on Gallowtree Gate.

Anyone unable to pick up their wristband in person can write to Visit Leicester, enclosing a stamped self-addressed envelope and a note saying how many wristbands they would like for the 6.30pm, 7.45pm or 9pm shows. Anyone wishing to receive their wristbands by post should make sure their stamped self-addressed envelope is delivered to Visit Leicester by Friday 22 February. Tickets cannot be reserved and will be issued on a first come, first served basis.

A limited number of tickets may be available on the gate, subject to availability

Disabled Access

There will be a disability viewing area at the front of stage. Access will be on a first come first served bases.

How can I get to the event?

The buses will be running on the normal Sunday service times.

On street parking in pay and display bays is free on a Sunday. However, vehicle drivers should always check the signs and lines to ensure further parking restrictions do not apply.

Newarke Street Car Park (LE1 5SN) will have special late opening for the event, closing at 10pm (last entrance at 9pm) with a £1 charge.

24 hour parking is also available in the following car parks; Haymarket (LE1 3YT), Dover Street (LE1 6PW), Phoenix Square (LE1 1TG), Upper Brown Street (LE1 5TH)

Weather

This is an outdoor event, and cover is not provided so please dress appropriately. The event will not be postponed due to weather conditions.

Seating

This is a standing event and chairs will not be provided. Small folding chairs can be bought with you but they must be small in size due to the capacity of the site. Please bear in mind this may affect your view.

Road Closures

A Traffic Order will be in place during the event and will come into effect between 4pm and 10pm always read diversion road signs to avoid penalties in the city centre.

Disabled parking bays on Market Place South will be removed from 12am 3rd March 2019.

Age Restriction

There is no age restriction for the content of this show. It will be entertaining, informative and a spectacular visual experience which can be enjoyed by all ages.

Toilets

Toilets will be open on Market Place for the duration of the event.
