Dumelow's Dairy is a family-run farm offering raw cow's milk. Their vending machine is open daily, providing fresh, unpasteurised and unhomogenised milk straight from the cow. It is one of a handful of places in the country to sell raw milk. The kiosk also sometimes sells free-range duck eggs and other farm produce.

The Tap: 76 Market St, Ashby-de-la-Zouch, LE65 1AP; Milking Parlour: Southwood House Farm, Staunton Ln, Calke, LE65 1RG

Two venues run by Tollgate Brewery. The Tap at No. 76 is a buzzing micropub in Ashby, and The Milking Parlour is a brewery tap in a rustic dairy shed on the National Trust's Calke Abbey Estate, also the home to Tollgate's six-barrel brewery plant. In 2012, Tollgate relocated to Calke Abbey and brought brewing back to the Estate for the first time in many years.
