Leicester's biggest free family festival is set to bring the city's waterways and parks alive once again with a fun-packed programme of activities for all ages.

The annual Riverside Festival returns on Saturday 1 and Sunday 2 June, spread over five areas: Bede Park, Castle Gardens, Western Boulevard, the Mile Straight of the River Soar and De Montfort University (DMU) Campus.

Celebrating 25 Years!

Leicester's first Riverside Festival started back in 1997 and was a simple Sunday afternoon event on the banks of the River Soar. Over the past 25 years the festival has developed into Leicester's largest free festival, with a weekend of programming across multiple sites and up to 40,000 visitors. 2024 will be no exception and we are pleased to announce our new partnership with De Montfort University, enabling more opportunity for the festivals growth.

Music

The Riverside Festival sits on a site of incredible history, so take the opportunity over the weekend to visit some of these key locations and landmarks including Castle Motte, St Mary De Castro Church ground, The Magazine, Newarke Houses Museum and The Stephen Lawrence Research Centre.

Some DMU buildings will only be open on Saturday from 12noon including, Trinity Chapel, DMU Museum, Leicester Castle Business School, and DMU The Gallery.

As well as the self-guided Heritage Trail, where you can stroll through thousands of years of history, there are opportunities to view physical and digital photography archives.

Leicester Museums

Visit the 1950s fire engine and 164, Leyland double decker bus from the Leicester Museums Technology Association.

Cabinet of Curiosity is out on tour! Bringing together objects and artifacts from the natural world.

Riverside Land Train

For many years Bede Island South was home to Vic Berry's locomotive scrapyard until it was redeveloped. You can view some of these images on Bede Park and on the DMU screen.

To honour this hop aboard the Land Train and take a ride around DMU Campus to some of the heritage spots you can visit over the weekend. Visitors can get on and off the Land Train at the designated Train Stop near Trinity House on The Newarke.

Extreme Mountain Bike Show


Danny Butler, multiple British and European Mountain Bike Trials champion will be onsite with his demonstration team. For any visiting cyclists there will be a free secure bike park.




Chilled Ibiza Classics

Enjoy a fun interactive space with craft workshops and art activities including textile.


Get creative with local arts and education charity, Pedestrian and create a masterpiece to take home.

For others wanting to stay a little drier, take a stroll down the tow path to check out the trade boats that will be joining us for the weekend.


Keep an eye out for the Sea Cadets demos and Leicestershire Fire and Rescue displays.

Dragon Boat Racing (Sunday)


Dragon Boat racing returns to the waters, taking place opposite the Castle Gardens bridge.
