Festival highlight

Abbey Park Bonfire & Firework Display

Saturday 4 November 5pm – 9pm Abbey Park

Be dazzled by Leicester's biggest bonfire & firework display as Abbey Park once again hosts the city's official firework and bonfire night festivities. Enjoy a fun-packed programme of events for all ages, including live entertainment, music stage with guest appearance by GEM FM's Jo & Sparky, funfair, plenty of hot food stalls and new for 2023, the addition of a licensed bar.

Gates open at 5pm with live music and entertainment at 6pm, followed by the children's firework display and lighting of the bonfire at 6.45pm. The countdown to the main firework display starts at 8pm, with musical entertainment continuing until 9pm.

There will be no cash sales on the gate and all tickets should be purchased in advance. Firework fans are encouraged to buy their tickets early to take advantage of our early bird offers, the best-value way to enjoy the fun!

Diwali Wheel of Light

The 110-foot Ferris wheel returns for Diwali Leicester, providing amazing views across the Golden Mile and extra fun to this year's celebrations. Each ride lasts for approximately 8 to 10 minutes, in which you'll rise to a dizzying 110 feet.

Diwali Lights Switch-On

Sunday 29 October 3pm – 9pm Cossington Street Recreation Ground and Belgrave Road

Diwali Leicester festivities begin with the illumination of the Diwali lights along Belgrave Road, marking the 40th anniversary of the switch on event in Leicester.

Up to 40,000 people watch the lights switch-on with an evening of entertainment including a vibrant programme of music and dance on the Belgrave Road stage and a fantastic firework display. Don't miss the annual Rangoli exhibition at Belgrave Neighbourhood Centre plus food, stalls and funfair rides in the Diwali Village on Cossington Recreation Ground. Diwali Day


Sunday 12 November 3pm - 9pm Cossington Street Recreation Ground and Belgrave Road

40th Anniversary celebrations continue on the 'Golden Mile' for Diwali Day, where visitors can enjoy a programme of music and dance on Belgrave Road's main stage with an aerial fireworks display.
